Some = adjective

Some disagree.
Some = pronoun
Students

antecedent = the word a
↳ before pronoun replaces

Sam ate sushi. He got sick afterward.

adjective not pronoun
Some people like Reebok.

Some like Nike.
└ pronoun replaces "people"

antecedent = noun replaced
