- 2 What is a topic sentence?
  - 2.1 The first sentence of a paragraph
  - 2.2 Summarizes what the entire paragraph will be about
  - 2.3 Usually makes a **claim**
  - 2.4 YOUR OWN WORDS never a quotation or example; often your opinion
- 3 What is a concrete detail?
  - 3.1 Facts/evidence used to back up your topic sentences
  - 3.2 Quotations, examples, proof, evidence
  - 3.3 Called concrete because they can be seen or touched they are facts
  - 3.4 <u>Always</u> begins with a transition element (For example, for instance, in addition, additionally, finally)
  - 3.5 MIGHT NOT BE YOUR OWN WORDS
- 4 What is commentary?
  - 4.1 Your interpretation of the facts
  - 4.2 Your explanation of the facts
  - 4.3 Your opinions!
  - 4.4 **Never** begins with a transition element
  - 4.5 YOUR OWN WORDS
- 5 What is a "chunk"?
  - 5.1 1 concrete detail with 2 sentences of commentary
  - 5.2 Minimum of 2 chunks in paragraph; maximum of 4
